SUBJECT: Generic 701 Catalog Description.

It just came to my attention that the standard catalog description for 701 courses on page 53 of the EPPM is not generic. I suggest the edits highlighted below to remove any confusion:

701 Master's Independent Capstone Project and /or Examination V 1-6 May be repeated for credit. **Course Prerequisite: Admitted to an online degree program or graduate certificate in communication. May be specified as appropriate.** Capstone project or final examination for professional master's degree under the Graduate School. The credits will include a balloted evaluation of the student's completion of the program's capstone/examination requirements by the program's graduate faculty. Students must have graduate degree-seeking status and obtain approval from their major advisor/committee chair before enrolling for 701 credit. S, U grading.
