RE: Recommendation for the EPPM Revisions to Review Process.

In order to increase clarity and to be consistent with the review processes passed by the senate in 2024, we have revised sections 4, 5, 13, 22, and 29.

Section 4: Existing language regarding committee review was inaccurate; we corrected it to be consistent with current review procedures.

Section 5: The primary update here was to clarify the types of substantive changes and the process required by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU) base on the type of organizational and/or degree change planned.

Section 13: We revised this section to be consistent with changes the Senate made in 2024 – implementation of the course review system and ending review of program changes by the graduate studies committee.

Section 22: We updated this section to be consistent with the changes to review processes that the senate made in 2024. This includes required documentation and processes for curricular change requests. Language clarified to be consistent with the revised AR27.
