The requirements listed below reflect major curricular changes for the professional health sciences and have been approved by the Catalog Subcommittee and the Professional Health Sciences Committee. The column to the far right indicates the date each change becomes effective. Note: Items marked {S} have been streamlined and do not require Catalog Subcommittee review.

<p>Medical Education and Clinical Sciences Revise requirements for professional certificate in Healthcare Leadership</p>	<p>Healthcare Leadership</p> <p>Academic Requirements:</p> <p>Pre-clerkship Curriculum</p> <p>Students must successfully complete all required courses in the pre-clerkship curriculum (6 <u>5</u> credits), MED LMH 501, 502, 503, 511, 512, and 513.</p> <p>Clinical Curriculum</p> <p>Students must successfully complete all required courses in the clinical clerkships (6 <u>5</u> credits), MED LMH 521, 522, 523, 531, <u>and 532</u>, and 533.</p> <p>Additional Requirements:</p> <p>ESFCOM Year 4: Capstone Leadership Paper/Project</p> <p>Students are required to complete a 10-page paper during the 4th year (with a mentor/advisor). The paper must focus on lessons learned during the leadership certificate courses, medical school clerkships, research and/or healthcare-related volunteer activities.</p> <p>If combined with a student's scholarly project, the leadership portion must comprise a related, additional 10-page analysis - i.e. this has to <u>must</u> be a separate paper or portion of the scholarly project. Students wishing to combine their leadership capstone paper with their scholarly project must receive formal approval signed off by both the Assistant Dean for Medical Student Scholarship and the Leadership in Medicine and Healthcare Course Director.</p>	<p align="center">8-26</p>
