RE: Proposal - Extend BS in Computer Science to WSU Everett

The Faculty Senate Library Committee discussed the proposal to extend the BS in Computer Science to WSU Everett. This has no impact on library resources, and we unanimously approve the proposal.

The FLSC offers one reminder as part of this approval. The Revised Proposal document is an email exchange between Haylee Hansen, Office of the Provost and Executive Vice President informs Jacob Murray, Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs and Assistant Professor (Career Track) and Program Coordinator for the School of Electrical Engineering and Computer Science at WSU Everett. In the final bullet point of this document, Vice Chancellor Murray agrees to “continue to coordinate with Dean Bond to address the library’s needs for this extension.” because “the institutional subscription to *Lecture Notes in Computer Science* has been discontinued”. As of the FSLC meeting, Vice Chancellor Murray had not contacted the library, however Dean Bond did not view this as problematic. The committee approved the proposal with the understanding that Dean Bond and Vice Chancellor Murray would connect later if needed.
